Thus, to inaugurate the 10th anniversary of the event, the committee is proposing a very interesting activity that will be open to all artists of Vaudreuil-Soulanges area: the Enc'Art Challenge! This will take place during the exhibition opening, on Saturday, July 8.

What is the challenge about? Creating an art piece in 90 minutes, on the Pincourt Library field, to sell at the auction. Each artist will have an assigned covered location on the field. The ambiance will be inspiring with the music of Kimberley Beyea Trio. In case of rain, the event will take place inside the Chêne-Bleu High School.

Each artist will have the responsibility to bring their own material and also, to respect the time given for the creation of the art piece. Note that it will be possible to prepare the background of the canvas in advance. Moreover, all mediums will be accepted.

Once the time elapsed, Encan Québec will start the live auction. The artist will determine the starting sale price and 20 % of the amount will be given to the *Groupe de Soutien pour l'Arthrite et l'Arthrose* (GSSAA).

The volunteers of GSSAA will be present to provide you refreshments.
A *Kids section* will be organized, in order to participate to a collective drawing project.
