Useful information: dormant lawn

Tips:

- Did you know that the less you water your lawn, the less it becomes dependant on water? Consequently, it can survive with less water in the future.
- **Good to know:** When your lawn goes yellow, it's because it's going into a dormant stage (see photo below). You don't need to water it. With the next rain, it will regain its strength and its green colour.
- When grass is dormant, you should refrain from trampling it or mowing it.
- When you water your lawn, you should give it a deep soaking, so direct the spray close to the ground rather than high in the air.
- Did you know that too much watering can have a harmful effect on your lawn?
 - Soil that is too wet weakens the root system, as it is more compacted, and promotes the growth of parasites and fungi.
