MOWERS AND TRIMMERS

Operating a lawn mower, a lawn tractor, an edger, a chain saw, a leaf blower, or any other power tool is prohibited before 10 a.m. and after 4:00 p.m. on Saturdays, Sundays, and statutory holidays.

CONSTRUCTION WORK

It is **forbidden** to perform or have carried out any construction, repair, or demolition work on a building between 8 p.m. and 7 a.m., Sunday to Friday and between 8 p.m. and 10 a.m., Friday to Sunday.

RECREATIONAL VEHICLE STORAGE

From March 15 to November 1 of the same year, you may park the following recreational vehicles in your front yard:

- Trailers
- Tent trailers
- Boats
- Off-road vehicles
- Motorized dwellings
- Trailers

CAR SHELTER

You have until April 15 to remove your winter car shelter from your property.
